From the Principal

We hope everyone has been enjoying this warmer weather. We certainly have here at school! Students have been having classes and eating lunch outside as well as extra recess time!

As many of you know, a week ago today the Governor outlined his plan for the lifting of some COVID protocols in the state. According to the governor and the MDH and with the backing of the Archdiocese, schools are to continue their current protocols and Safe Learning Plan for the remainder of the school year. Therefore, St. John's will continue to follow our current protocols:

- **MASKS:** Students and staff will still be required to wear masks while in the school building, during Mass and on school buses. As has been the case all year, students may remove their masks when outside for recess or gym. If there is a medical need for your child to wear a shield instead of a mask, this request must be made via email to the principal, Ms. Ann Laird, for her approval prior to your child wearing one during the school day. Please note Ms. Laird will ask for a note from your doctor prior to granting approval.
- **TEMPERATURE CHECKS:** We will continue to conduct temperature checks as students enter the building each school day.
- **DECISION TREE:** We will continue to follow the [MDH's Decision Tree](#) for symptoms and/or exposures.

- ⇒ Location for tutoring listed below or is determined with teacher; on-site St. John's tutoring may have a small cleaning fee in addition to the tutoring fee.
