We encourage our parents to connect, but do not want anyone to get hurt, so we ask that you please move to a safer and better play area while you visit - thank you!

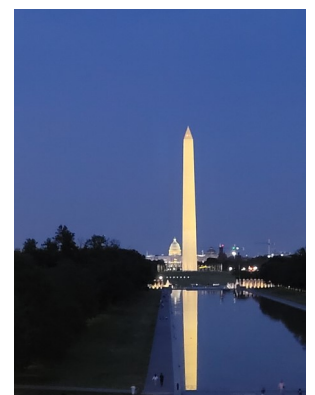
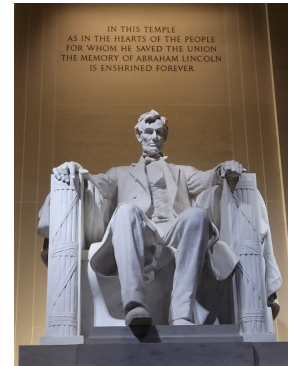
2020-21 Yearbooks

SUMMER TUTORING DETAILS:

- ⇒ In person tutoring will be offered.
- ⇒ Teachers will follow safety protocols, including wearing masks and sanitizing; students will also need to wear a mask.
- ⇒ Individualized plan for student; student meets with the teacher one-on-one.
- ⇒ Number of sessions per week, days and times are determined between the parent and teacher.
- ⇒ Cost-\$40 per hour; \$25 per ½ hour
- ⇒ Location for tutoring listed below or is determined with teacher; on-site St. John's tutoring may have a small cleaning fee in addition to the tutoring fee.
