We are happy to announce that we are bringing back "Move-Up Day" to St. John's. 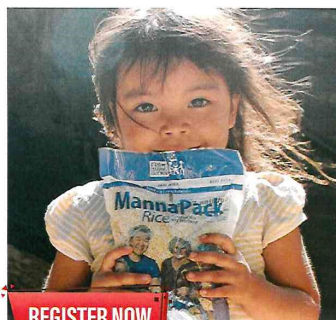
