From the Principal

Blessings as we enter into Holy Week beginning with Palm Sunday this Sunday, April 2nd. As you know, Easter is an important feast day for us. It is the fulfill-ment of God's promise to conquer sin and death so that we may have eternal life with Him. In order for Easter and the Resurrection to happen, God needed to send His Son so we could learn how to live in God's Kingdom and learn about his last days. Holy Week provides us with a unique opportunity to enter into those last days.

At school, we will be entering into His last days during our Holy Week Retreat where we will spend each of the 4 days of next week walking with Jesus. We will focus on Palm Sunday (Jesus' glorious entrance into Jerusalem), Holy Thursday (Last Supper and the institution of the Holy Eucharist), Good Friday (Jesus' crucifixion and death), and Easter (Jesus' Resurrection). During our 2023 Holy Week retreat, we are "Called Forth: An Invitation to Communion with the Lord." Students will participate in activities with their classes during a portion of each day. We will join as a whole school on three of the days and invite and encourage you to join us for the liturgies in the church on these days (shown below in BOLDED PURPLE)

- Monday, April 3rd Palm Sunday: An Invitation to "Follow Him"
- Tuesday, April 4th Holy Thursday: An Invitation "For anyone who thirsts, let them drink." MASS AT 1:30PM (Note: This Mass replaces our normal Mass time on Wednesday at 8:30am)
- Wednesday, April 5th Good Friday: An Invitation "To come and take up your cross." VENERATION OF THE CROSS AT 1:30PM
- Thursday, April 6th Resurrection: An Invitation to "Those blessed by the Father to inherit the Kingdom of Heaven." ADORATION AT 1:30PM

Aside from the above liturgies with the students, we also would like to encourage you to attend liturgies at St. John's during Holy Week. See below or on the St. John's Church website for a full list.



Grade School Day Program

The day program is for students entering grades 1-5 in the fall and is \$50. We will end the week with a human sundae and water fun!



Middle School & High School Evening Program

The evening program is for students entering grades 6-12 in the fall and is \$25. The program runs Sunday, July 23 through Thursday, July 27, 2023 from 7:00 pm - 9:15 pm and includes large group presentations, small group discussions, games, and night prayer. Students need to register whether they attend one day or the full week.

Totus Tuus is a Catholic summer youth program dedicated to proclaiming the Gospel and sharing the Catholic faith through evangelization, catechesis, Christian witness, and Eucharistic worship taught by college students. The program is split into the grade school day program and the middle school/high school evening program.

Good Friday Retreat


