

Grade School Day Program

The day program is for students entering grades 1-5 in the fall and is \$50. The program runs **Monday, July 24 through Friday, July 28, 2023** from 9:00 am - 2:30 pm and includes songs, skits, games, prayer, small groups, Mass, recess and large group presentations. We will end the week with a human sundae and water fun!



Middle School & High School Evening Program

The evening program is for students entering grades 6-12 in the fall and is \$25. The program runs Sunday, July 23 through Thursday, July 27, 2023 from 7:00 pm - 9:15 pm and includes large group presentations, small group discussions, games, and night prayer. Students need to register whether they attend one day or the full week.

Totus Tuus is a Catholic summer youth program dedicated to proclaiming the Gospel and sharing the Catholic faith through evangelization, catechesis, Christian witness, and Eucharistic worship taught by college students. The program is split into the grade school day program and the middle school/high school evening program.


