First Sacraments at St. John the Baptist

First Sacraments Registration is open for the fall.

The preparation for the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion are completed during second grade. Preparation includes parents guiding their children through weekly home lessons, attending parent/child orientations, retreats and celebrations. An early rate price is in effect now until August 1. This program is in addition to the religion classes your child receives in grade 2.
