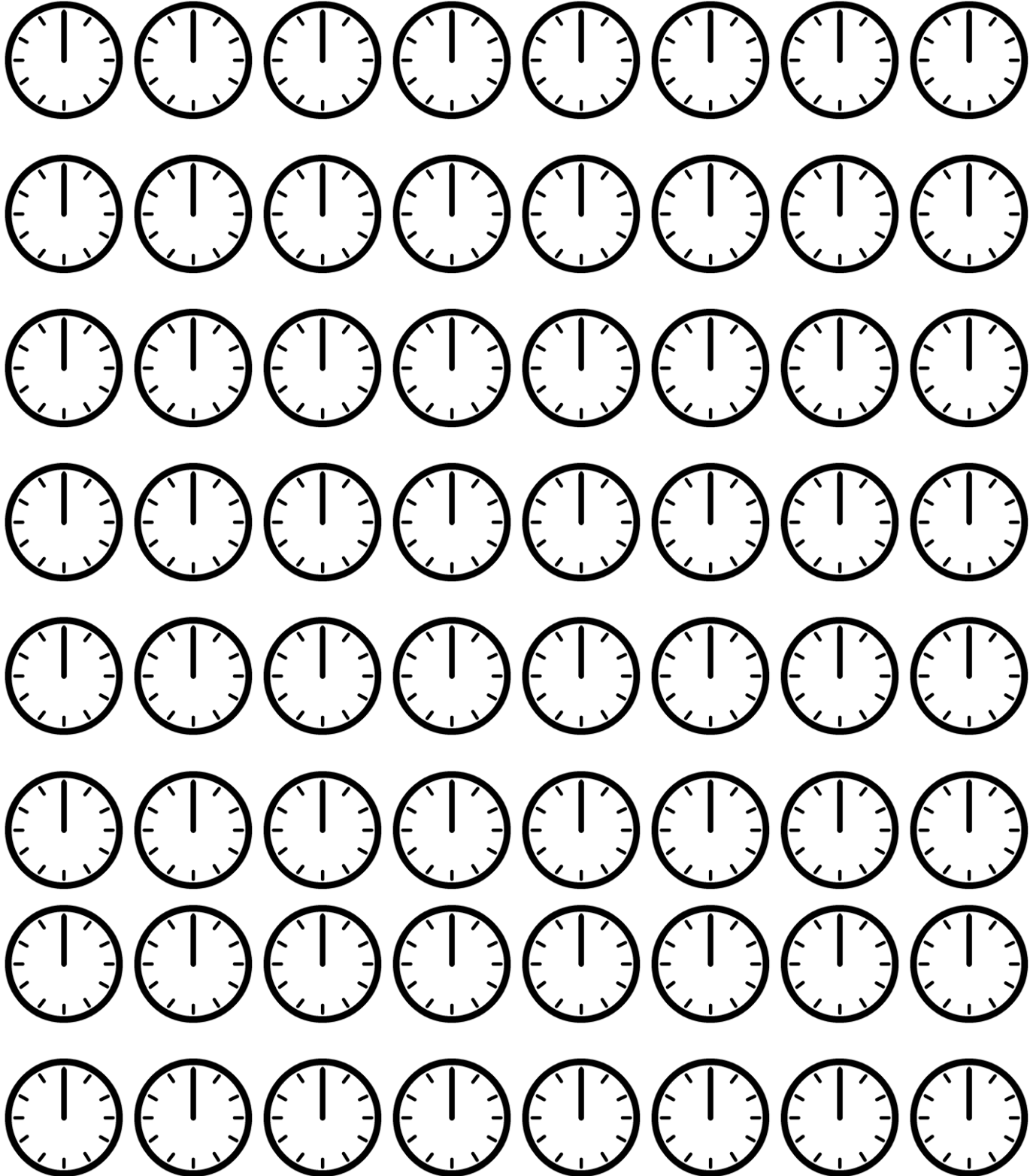

St. John the Baptist School Summer Reading Challenge

IT IS TIME FOR SUMMER VACATION!

We encourage all students to spend some time reading this summer to maintain their reading skills!

Research done by the Summer Reading Group shows that students need to spend time reading outside of school with about 20-30 minutes outside of school daily considered optimal for growth and maintaining growth. However, the study showed that students spent only about 10 minutes per day reading in the summer. (Summer Reading Group) Since reading is like most disciplines where it takes an adequate amount of quality practice to make or retain growth it makes sense that reading ability for students would decline over the summer without practice. (Reading Teacher)



Kindergarten through Second Grade Reading Challenge

10 hours of reading = ONE non-uniform pass

20 hours of reading = TWO non-uniform passes

30 or more hours of reading = THREE non-uniform passes



Third through Fifth Grade Reading Challenge

15 hours of reading = ONE non-uniform pass

30 hours of reading = TWO non-uniform passes

45 or more hours of reading = THREE non-uniform passes
