Medications Need to be Picked Up by Wednesday, June 7

Prescriptions cannot be stored at school over the summer. Medications left in the health office will be discarded unless prior arrangements have been made. You may pick up your child's emergency medication or prescription medication in the Health Office during regular school hours. To make other arrangements,

please contact the school office. Prescription Epinephrine, inhalers, and over-the-counter medications will be sent home with your child on the last day of school.
