

Cell Phone / Smartwatch Policy

St. John the Baptist School allows students in grades 4-8 to have cell phones and students in grades 3-8 to have smart watches at school under the following guidelines:
- Students in grades 4-8 are allowed to have a cell phone if the parents choose to allow their students to have them and have a signed policy on file.
 Students will turn in their phones upon arriving at school to their advisory/homeroom teacher. If the phone is visible during the school – on or off and used for ANY purpose, without teacher consent – the child will forfeit the phone and it will be given to the principal who will keep it for a week. At that time a parent needs to collect it and the chil will no longer be allowed to have it at school.
 Students may wear a smartwatch in school, however the watch must be placed on airplane mode or school mode. If a student misuses or repeatedly does not put or keep the smartwatch on the correct mode, they will forfeit the right to have it in school. At this time a parent will need to collect it from the school office.
