Blessings on this last full week of October!

As we head into this weekend, the weather is looking like it will be turning much colder with highs in the 30s and 40s into next week. Please make sure your students are dressed appropriately for the weather as they will continue to go outside for recess unless it's raining or the temperature is below 0°F (including the windchill). Remember to label your child's hats, gloves, etc. A reminder that beginning on November 1st, shorts are no longer to be worn as part of the uniform until April.

Looking ahead to November, this month is wonderful time to focus on all we have been given. At St. John's we are truly blessed to celebrate with each other, worship the Lord with each other, and learn with each other. We are also blessed to have you as partners in educating your children, it is a great gift. Please know of our gratitude for your support and sacrifices.

Below are some upcoming items to be aware of:

- Halloween Class Parties will be held on Tuesday, October 31st. Students may be out of uniform on this day. They should come dressed in Halloween colors or in an appropriate Halloween-themed shirt. Jeans and sweatpants are okay to wear on this day. Students in grades K-8 should NOT wear costumes to school. Preschool students may come in costume on their party days next week - please see your child's class calendar for information on what day that is. - All Saints Day Mass is Wednesday, November 1st at 8:30am. This is a Holy Day of Obligation and we look forward to seeing you all there. The Church has given us amazing witnesses in the saints of how to live in God's love. So please join us in gathering to witness and celebrate that love. If you are unable to celebrate Mass with us at 8:30am, the parish also offers the following Mass times on November 1st: 6:30am, 5:30pm and 7:00pm
- All Souls Day is November 2nd. This is a great day to remember all of those who have gone before us- parents, siblings, grandparents, aunts, uncles, etc. Please take some time to pray as a family for them or even attend Mass. St. John's will celebrate Mass at 8:30am and 7:00pm.
- There is No School on Friday, November 3rd for all students preschool through grade 8. This is a staff workday for our K-8 staff and preschool will be holding parent-teacher conferences. J-Care and Care Crew are available so please be sure to register for these programs online if you need them for your children.
- Fall Parent-Teacher Conference Signups for grades K-8 will begin Friday, November 3rd. As always families with three or more students will be able to sign up first and then we will open it to everyone else. Sign Up ends on Thursday, November 16th at 4:30pm. Conferences will be held in-person on November 20 and November 21 from 12:20-8:00pm on each day.



November Art Class Registration


8th Grade Washington D.C. Fundraisers
