Happy Non-Public School Marathon Weekend! This Saturday, October 7th, is our non-public school marathon event at Central Park in Roseville. Join us for fellowship and a little exercise. The marathon runs from 8:00am - 1:00pm, however, if you are able to, please join us at 9:00am as the SJB community gathers for prayer followed by a lap around the lake. Students who attend the Marathon on Saturday will receive a non uniform pass to be used on Monday, October 9th and will also be entered into a drawing. The SJB area is in the pavilion on the southwest side of the lake at the top of the hill, just past the band shell. Thank you to all who have donated to our marathon so far. After our third collection this week, we are a little over \$8,000 from our goal of \$70,000. We have one final collection date next week, so be sure to ask your family and friends for marathon donations for one final push to meet our goal! This Sunday, October 8th is our Middle School Grade Level Mass. Join us for Mass as our Middle School students serve our parish community by participating in the 10:30am Sunday Mass. MS students should wear their school uniform. I will be in the plaza following Mass with the passes for those middle school students who attend to come to school out of uniform on Tuesday, October 10th. If you have a Mass part please check in with a Middle School teacher upon your arrival. See you at Mass.

Please drive north on 2nd Avenue as normal, past the flagpole door (door #6) and make a right into the north lot. Stay in the line and exit the lot on the east side of the lot. For safety reasons, do not park in this lot and do not turn around and exit out the west side of the lot

Afternoon pickup will be from the main Church lot as normal.

Please Note the Following Regarding School Release Days:

- Hours of Operation: 7:00am-6:00pm (Hours may be altered based on number of students signed up.)
- Cancellation: If you are signed up for the school release day and cancel within one week of the actual school release day, you will be charged the full amount. No exceptions. You may cancel prior to the one-week window of the school release day. The cancellation must be written and signed by the parent/guardian.

- Lunch is not provided by the school or J-Care on school release days, so please send a lunch with your child(ren). Milk will be provided at no additional charge. If you do not send a lunch with your child(ren), you will be called to bring a lunch.
