Next week is Thanksgiving Week. Below are some items to note about next week's schedule:

- Students in grades K-8 will have two half days of school, in-person on Monday, November 20th and Tuesday, November 21st. School will start at 7:55am and end at 11:30am. There will be no breakfast or lunch served on either day.
- Monday and Tuesday are No Busing Days. Students who ride the MV District buses will need transportation to/from school on these two days. Morning drop off will be in the gym (north) parking lot at door 7. The 11:30am pickup will be from the main Church lot. The SJB chartered buses to Blaine will run on these two days parents please see the email that was sent to Blaine bus riders earlier this week regarding timing.
- Parent-Teacher Conferences for students in grades Kindergarten through grade 8 will be held on Monday, November 20th and Tuesday, November 21st from 12:20-8:00pm. Please note that sign up for conferences ends today at 4:30pm. If you have a conflict that comes up before your conferences

next week and you need to change your conference schedule, please contact the school office between 7:30am-3:30pm. You may use doors 4, 12 or the main Church doors to enter the building and walk to the school office area. The doors up the stairs from the school office will be the only ones unlocked during conferences.

- J-Care is available for students in grades K-8 on Monday and Tuesday from 11:30am - 6:00pm and Wednesday from 7:00am - 6:00pm. Students attending J-Care should have registered online (deadline was November 15th). If you still need care on these days, please reach out to our J-Care Director, Miss Mac-Kenzie Kantor, at <u>kantorm@stjohnnyb.org</u> or on the J-Care phone 651-261-9113. Reminder that students attending J-Care should bring a lunch from home.
- Preschool has normal, full-day classes on both Monday and Tuesday. Preschool Care Crew is only available on Monday and Tuesday. There is no Care Crew available on Wednesday.
- There is no school for all students in preschool through grade 8 on Wednesday, November 22nd through Friday, November 24th for the Thanksgiving break. Classes will resume on Monday, November 27th.
