Happy Advent! We have had a busy first week of Advent with our Advent Confessions, a visit from St. Nick, and tomorrow celebrating the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. As we look toward the second week of Advent, we are called by St. John the Baptist to make straight the path so that we are ready for the coming of Christ. In addition to preparing for Christmas, we are also practicing the virtue of patience.

Here are some reminders for the next few weeks:

- Join us for Mass tomorrow, Friday, December 8th at 8:30am where we will be celebrating the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation. If you are unable to attend this mass, St. John's also has the following Masses for this Holy Day: Vigil Mass at 5:30pm tonight, December 7, and 6:30am and 7:00pm tomorrow, Friday, December 8.
- Our SJB band concert is Monday, December 11th at 6:30pm in the Church. Come and listen to our talented students!
- Join Phoenix School Counseling and Dr. Jules Nolan for a Parenting in Unpredictable Times Parent Webinar on Tuesday, December 12 at 7 PM. Discussion will be on how the holidays provide parents with lots of experiences of unpredictability and address strategies to bolster your child's resilience during these times. <u>Register for the webinar here</u>. - The SJB Christmas Shop will be here next week on Tuesday, December 12th and Wednesday, December 13th. This is an optional activity for students, however, all K-8 classes will visit the shoppe during the two days. The Christmas Shoppe is run by the PTO and allows our students (in grades K-8) the opportunity to buy gifts for their family and friends. Students will come home with a shopping list and envelope. Cash or check (to St. John's) accepted.
- SJB Christmas Concerts are Friday, December 15th for Preschool through grade 2 at 12:45pm and Tuesday, December 19th for grades 3-8 at 7:00pm. We do expect all our students to participate in the Christmas concert. Dress for students for both concerts is "Christmas best." Students in preschool through grade 2 may wear their outfits to school on the 15th. Please note that dress should be appropriate for the occasion. All concerts will take place in the Church.
- Class Christmas parties are Thursday, December 21st. Students may come out of uniform on this day wearing Christmas colors or a Christmas themed shirt. Jeans or sweatpants are okay for students to wear on this day.
- There is no school for Christmas break from Friday, December 22nd through Monday, January 1st. School resumes on Tuesday, January 2nd.
- Christmas will be celebrated at SJB on Sunday, December 24th with 4:00pm, 6:00pm and 10:30pm Masses and on Monday, December 25th with 8:30am and 10:30am Masses. Please note that the Christmas Eve Mass does not count as your Sunday Mass commitment for the 4th Sunday of Advent.

As we move into winter, we want to remind everyone of our severe weather policy and how we notify you of any potential school closures due to winter weather. SJB typically follows the Mounds View Public School District for severe weather school cancellations or early dismissal. If we are canceling school, we will notify you as soon as possible via the following methods:

- 1. All families will be emailed with the notification of the closure. This email will be sent to the same distribution list as the Principal's Bulletin each week.
- 2. Notification of the school closure will be shown on the school website (www.stjohnnyb.org)
- 3. The school closure will be listed on all four of the local news channels (WCCO 4, KSTP 5, KMSP 9 and KARE 11). The notification will be listed as St. John the Baptist or St. John's with New Brighton noted.
- 4. If significant winter weather develops during the school day, the district may decide to stage buses early. If this happens, we will again email families this information and post it on our school website. Please note that we do our best to notify families as soon as we get the information from the school district, but sometimes we are not able to give you much advance notice.

Additionally, please make sure your child comes appropriately dressed for the weather and recess. Students will continue to go outside for recess everyday unless it is raining or the temperature, including the wind chill is below 0°F. If there is snow, please remember boots and snowpants. Remember to label everything!

Morning Drop Off: Just a reminder that with winter weather the roads can be "messy" and slow travel in the morning and our car drop off line can get backed up. In order to speed up the drop off line, please use the entire sidewalk and have your children exit the car as soon as you are stopped along the sidewalk which runs the full length of the school playground. Finally, just a reminder that if you are driving up and it is 7:50am or later, please drive around and drop your child(ren) off at the school office. Our staff need to be able to get to their respective classrooms/areas to be ready for the students, so we need to close the outside doors at 7:50am.

Finally, we hope you have been working on your Advent Challenge. The Advent Challenge went home last Friday and is a wonderful way for your children and the entire family to prepare for Christmas. Remember that the turn in day for the challenge in on Thursday, December 21st!
