## From the Principal

January 18, 2024

Enrollment for the 2024-2025 school year will open tomorrow, Friday, January 19th. Current SJB families will receive an email from TADS with information on how to enroll your student(s). New families will also be able to begin to submit applications. All current families should have received an email this morning with the following information:

- Your child is NOT enrolled for the next school year until you log on to TADS and confirm their enrollment. It is a simple and quick process!
- It is better to enroll sooner rather than later, especially if your child's grade is nearing capacity (50 students).
- When you are enrolling your child(ren), you do have the option to add a new
  application if you have a child that is not yet attending our school. For example, if you have a child ready to start preschool, you will be able to fill out an
  application at this time.
- If you know someone interested in attending our school, please let them know that they will be able to apply tomorrow morning.
- The <u>tuition agreement</u> is now available on our school website. Please take note of the new volunteer requirement (25 hours or a \$600 fee) as well as the second page that includes the Tuition and Fees Billing and Collection Policies.

#### Preschool Families:

- Your child is automatically put in the next level of preschool or moved to kindergarten based on their age. If you see that the grade is not correct, you will see a dropdown menu that will allow you to change the grade. For example, if your child is able to go to kindergarten based on their age, the system will place them in kindergarten. You will have the option to put them into another year of Pre-K if that is what you would like to do.
- If you are ready to enroll in kindergarten, you will have until January 26<sup>th</sup> at 12pm to enroll your child. We will begin to accept new families into our kindergarten class that day. If you have not yet enrolled, you could forfeit your spot.
- In order for your child to enroll in kindergarten, he/she MUST be 5 by September 1, 2024.

## Restore to Gather - Capital Campaign for St. John the Baptist



We have recently reached a HUGE milestone for our school and church! The Restore to Gather campaign has **surpassed \$4 million in gifts and pledges!** This means that we are 81% to our \$5 million goal. We are very close to being able to *Restore* our school campus and accomplish the necessary upgrades. We need your help to accomplish these improvements as well as fund our school operations endowment.

## Matching Gift Challenge! YOUR GIFT WILL BE DOUBLED!

You still have the opportunity to double your pledge with our matching gift challenge! A group of parishioners and friends are matching any pledge up to a total of \$200,000 through the month of January. This means that for every \$1 given to the campaign, the donors will give \$1. If you pledge a gift of \$3,000 (\$1,000 per year for three years), the donors will give a matching gift of \$3,000, making your total gift \$6.000!

#### **CORPORATE MATCHING GIFTS**

Many companies will match charitable contributions to qualifying non-profits. We have already received word of \$57,000 in matching gifts from corporations that employ current or former school parents. Please check with your employer if they match funds made to our school. Most companies will only match gifts made directly to the school and not the church. In most cases you will need to designate your gift to a specific school project in order to be eligible for the employer match.



## **NEW Merit-Based Scholarships!**

New this year, students can apply for a variety of scholarships based on their parish involvement as altar servers, liturgical ministers, serving at parish events, and participating in bible studies and discipleship groups. Each student may apply for multiple scholarships using one application. There is no limit to the amount of money that a student can be awarded. Applications will open on May 1st and are due on June 1st and will be based on the previous program year from June-May. For now, you can make a deposit of \$100 per camper and follow up with the scholarship application later. We encourage you to set goals with your child to earn a variety of scholarships over the course of this year.
