

## **NEW Merit Based Scholarships for Summer Camp - 6th-12th graders**

Students can apply for a variety of scholarships based on their parish involvement as altar servers, liturgical ministers, serving at parish events, and participating in bible studies and discipleship groups. Each student may apply for multiple scholarships using one application. There is no limit to the amount of money that a student can be awarded. Applications will open on May 1st and are due on June 1st and will be based on the previous program year from June-May. For now, you can make a deposit of \$100 per camper and follow up with the scholarship application later. We encourage you to set goals with your child to earn a variety of scholarships over the course of this year.
