If you would like to apply for help with school tuition, this application must be completed by March 15th. Note that to be eligible for Aim Higher or CSAF grants, this deadline is February 23rd.

In general, teachers would like to meet with all kindergarten families. For students in grades 1-8, conferences can be teacher or parent requested. More information will be coming regarding conferences, but please keep these dates in mind.
