### Happy March!

The virtue for March is temperance, which is enjoying things in a proper, balanced way. This is a great virtue for us to practice especially as we enter into the last month of Lent. Some saints that we will be studying are St. Teresa of Avila, St. Camillus de Lellis and Ven. Matt Talbot.

We continue to assist our students to prepare their hearts during this Lenten season.

- Students in grades 2-8 will have the opportunity to receive the sacrament of reconciliation next week on Tuesday, March 5th (grades 2-5) or Wednesday, March 6th (grades 6-8). This is a wonderful way for our students to prepare themselves to receive the graces of the sacrament and Jesus in their hearts this Lent.
- We have two opportunities for school Stations of the Cross during the month of March: Tuesday, March 5th at 12:30pm and Thursday, March 21st at 1:00pm.
- Students will also be participating in a Holy Week retreat the week of March 25th. This is an annual retreat where we spend a short time each day stepping up close to Jesus as we follow His final days on earth from Palm Sunday through the Resurrection on Easter Sunday.

The second trimester ends tomorrow, Friday, March 1st and we will be holding our spring conferences next week on March 5th and 6th. These conferences will be held in-person. If you are meeting with teachers for conferences, please enter the school upstairs from the school office and walk to the appropriate classroom for your conference. Faux Stained Glass Crosses, Grades K-4, 12 students; \$25

March 4, 2024

Using color tissue and contact paper, students will create a faux stained-glass window cross to put in a window at home to share their Catholic faith with everyone!





Wood & Twine Crosses, Grades 4-8, 12 students; \$25 March 6, 2024

Using twine, wood, and paint, students will create a simple but beautiful Cross craft. Students will also have a choice to add nails or flowers as ornamentation to their crosses to reflect the crucifixion or the resurrection.
